Types of Information We Collect

We collect two kinds of information about our online visitors through our website: personal and non-personal information.

Personal Information: You are not required to provide any personal information to access our website. We collect personal information that can identify a visitor, such as name, address, telephone number, and e-mail address only when you voluntarily provide it. Non-Personal Information: When you visit our website, certain information is gathered automatically through tracking technologies.
